Join local instructor **Angie Merritt** as she guides us through techniques to improve flexibility and strength. The experience is both calming and healing. The class is appropriate for all ages and genders, and no previous experience is required.

Feb. 24 - Fundamentals of Baking Bread

We all need bread, but have you ever kneaded bread? Bread aficionado **Ellen Burnett** will guide participants in this hands-on course, and you'll even have a chance to sample her famous Danish

Feb. 26 & 27 - Beginning Painting for Anyone

No experience needed for this 2-part session to explore the art of painting. Master artist **Susan Watson** promises no stress - just fun. Participants will create a 16"x20" canvas to take home. Sessions will be from 4:30 - 6:30 p.m. each day. Class requires only one fee. *Supplies - additional \$15.

Mar. 2 & 3 - Beginning Knitting

Diana Lane, owner of the Yarn Parlour in Rocky Mount, will give the basics of knitting to participants who will making a dish cloth. Their is a \$5 charge for yarn, and participants should bring their own size 8 knitting needles.

Mar. 5 - Decorating Gourds

Master crafter **Diana Dillard** will start with the basics of gourd design, and participants will make their own ladybug refrigerator magnet to take away. You'll be amazed at the many gourd creations.

Mar. 12 - Beautiful Blessings

In time for Easter, **April McKee** of Mill City Market will guide us to make a Beautiful Blessings floral cross on wood. Techniques include whitewashing, painting leaves and flowers, and distressing wood. *Supplies - additional \$5
